Dean Olevsky called the meeting to order at 11:02 am.

1) Announcement & Updates

- A) Kate Carinder, Senior Director of Development for Engineering, provided the following updates: i) 2018-19 CoE raised over \$6M; ii) Development FY 19-20 goal is \$4M; and iii) the CoE received two gifts from our College, Supernak Award for Excellence and the Daisy Galeana and Theresa M. Garcia MESA Collaborative Annex.
- B) Dean Olevsky provided the following updates: i) (2) new staff hires: Bianca Avina, School Programs Manager, Femineer Program and Lance Rallof, Program Coordinator for ANSWER; and ii) Six faculty searches for 2020-21: (4) Assistant Professor positions and (2) Associate Dean positions.

2) State of the College

Dean Olevsky covered the following topics:

- A) 19/20 instructional budget & operational budget status
- B) Undergraduate Program Eligibility index reached high levels in the past couple of years, which caused a decrease in yield rate.
- C) Research and Graduate Program:
 - 1) Research awards to Engineering PIs in the past year approached \$8.5M.

- 2) JDP enrollment continues to increase.
- 3) MS programs, enrollment has been declining over the past few years.
- 4) University plan for Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) There are nine members in the CoE DEI Council.

3) Approval of 8/22/2019 Fall 2019 CoE Retreat Minutes

The minutes of the 8/22/19 Fall 2019 CoE Retreat were unanimously approved by all faculty present.

4) Dr. Steve Welter (VP Research & Dean of Graduate Affairs) - College Research & JDP Program

Dr. Welter addressed issues regarding:

- A) Ph.D. students: Admit/enrollment/total # increase over the past five years. There is a risk that for future JDP students there will not be sufficient funding from the University to cover JDP expenses. Additional external funding sources are needed.
- B) New funding programs, NRTW, and TA net funding could be the potential solutions to the JDP financial issue.
- C) Extended discussions amongst Dr. Welter and CoE faculty regarding grant matching mechanism and University, College, Departments and faculty need to be involved. Equipment fund awards to be disclosed soon.
