5. JDP Program Update

- Number of enrolled students in Spring 2022 was 60.
 - Number of graduates in Spring/Summer 2022 was 9.
 - Number of continuing students is 51.
 - Number of admitted students for Fall 2022 is 17.
 - 13 submitted intent to enroll.
 - 9 may enroll in Fall 2022 (assuming 70% yield)
 - Dr. Dongye Zhao will transfer two students from Auburn University
 - Anticipated Fall 2022 enrollment = 51 + 9 + 2 = 62

- 2. Asst. Dean Garcia shared that OPT/Internship opportunities for international students to work in the US and receive general studies course credit is being discussed. Currently, there is one course available.

11. GI 2025 Update

Asst. Dean Garcia shared the following update:

- 1. New student orientation is from July 8-29, 2022, and transfer student orientation is from August 1-11, 2022.
- 2. There will be breakout sessions with the major advisors during student orientations.
- 3. Student orientations will be offered in a hybrid mode.
- 4. RAAR Forms will still be routed to each department for review and signatures.
- 5. Asst. Dean Garcia shared the math transfer credit problem between community colleges and SDSU.
