

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, September 07, 2022 2:00pm-4:30pm, Meeting to be held via Zoom

Dean Olevsky called the meeting to order at 2:04 pm.

1. Approval of 08/17/2022 Exec. Comm. Mtg. Minutes

2. <u>University Administration Meetings</u>

Dean Olevsky shared the following update from the ADC Meeting:

ADC Meeting:

- 1. Dean Olevsky reported on the discussion of new aspects of the SDSU RTP process to be implemented next year.
- 2. Dean Olevsky shared Fall 2022 enrollment data of the university and the college. Dean Olevsky shared the final new 2023/24 five faculty positions for CoE: 1 (AE), 2 (ECE 1 new and 1 carry-over), 2 (ME 1 new and 1 carry-over).
- 3. Dean Olevsky updated on the approach to hiring GA/TA/ISA's.

3. CoE Space Allocation

Dean Olevsky shared the following update:

- 1. Dean Olevsky reported that the university hired SmithGroup Firm to survey space allocation across the university.
- 2. SmithGroup Firm sent the CoE their survey of room allocations to review and update any missing information. Dean Olevsky, Associate Dean Garoma, and J. Smitherman reviewed and updated the information.
- 3. Dean Olevsky shared a data table of space allocations by department. The CoE inventory consists of offices and/or lab spaces in the following buildings: Engineering, EIS, PSFA, Education, Adams Humanities, and A Building.

9. Advising Update

Asst. Dean Garcia shared the following update:

- 1. Table comparing CSSE visits (in-person/virtual and email/text/phone) from: 08/23/2021-09/03/2021 and 08/22/22-09/02/2022.
 - 08/23/2021-09/03/2021: 419 students visited CSSE (217 were distinct students).
 - 08/22/2022-09/02/2022: 449 students visited CSSE (325 were distinct students).
- 2. Advising Goal for 2022/23: All engineering students will have a Master Plan on file.
- 3. Asst. Dean Garcia shared the number of Under-enrolled students as of 08/23/2022.
 - 524 students surveyed: 198 responded, 98 requested contact.
 - FASS contact FTF.
 - Take aways: Schedules that are in progress, 33% of students needed <12 units, waitlist issues, and PT vs. FT and tuition.
- 4. Graph of the Under-enrolled survey of students who are planning to enroll in 12 or more units and why are they currently in less than 12 units.
- 5. Graph of the Under-enrolled survey of students who intend to enroll in 11 units or less for Fall 2022 and the reasons why.
